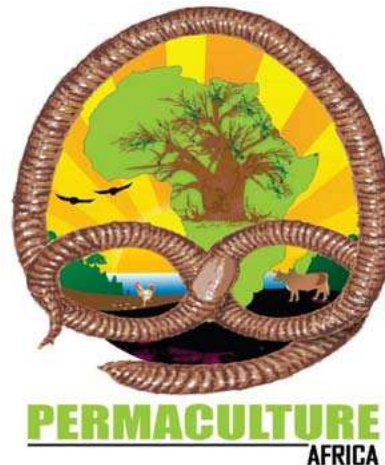
About Labata Fantalle

Labata Fantalle aims to positively affect change in the lives of the Karrayyu community who are entirely dependent on the continued health of their land and who currently face many challenges in sustaining their survival.

By providing Permaculture training community members can learn how to take care of their land and improve their yields which will guarantee them a food secure future and healthy environment for both themselves and their livestock.

We are only limited by our funding. Donations are so important to what we do, and your donation *will* make a positive difference. In Ethiopia even small donations can go a long way.

£10 is enough to provide our project site with enough seedlings to get started.

£25 is enough to provide the site with shovels, picks and watering cans to maintain the garden.

£90 is enough to provide practical training for a whole day for dozens of community members.
